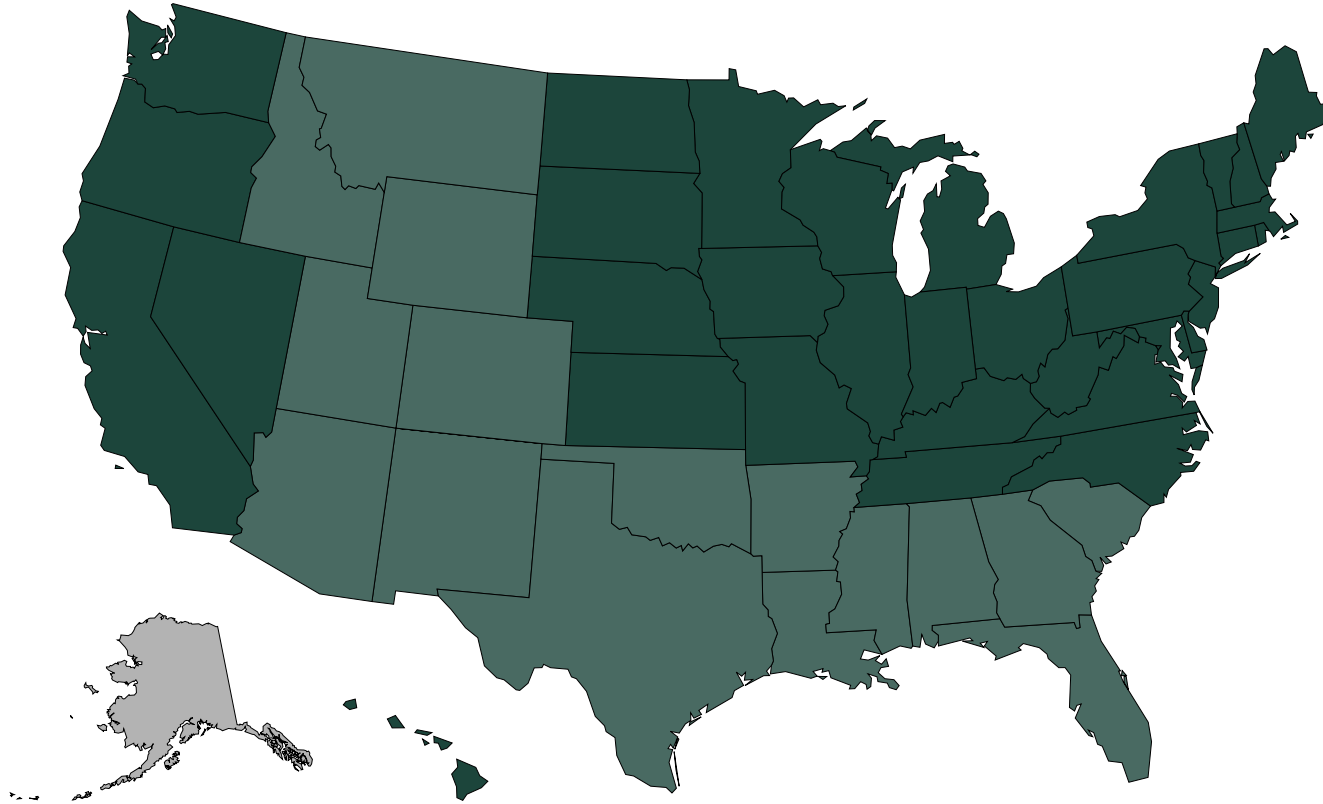
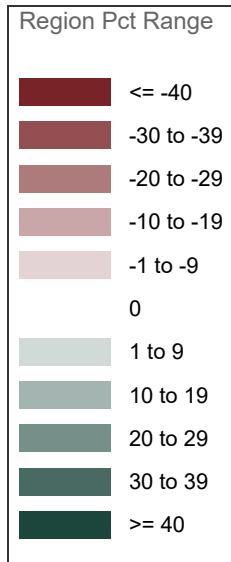


## Notes:

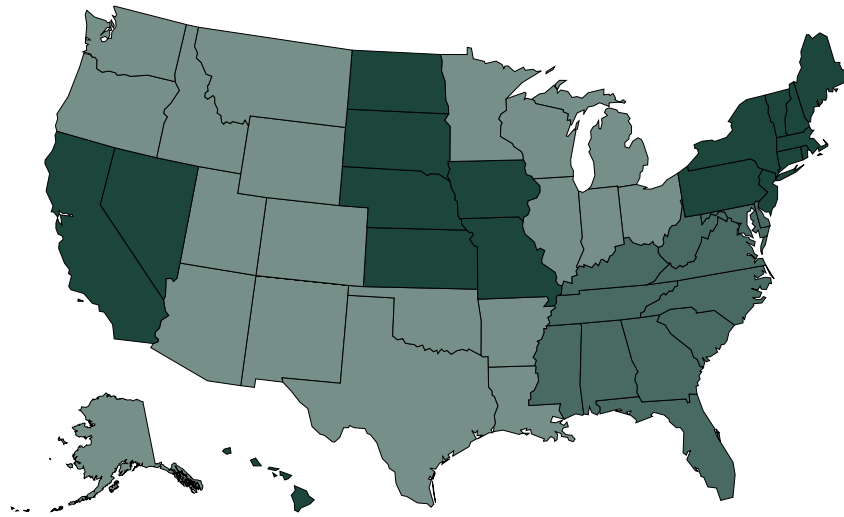
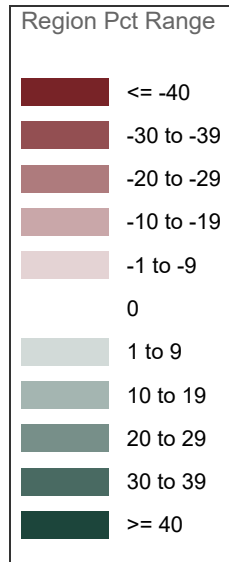
Currently there are 187 schools with an application volume increase, while 11 show a volume decrease, and 1 schools show no change in application volumes.

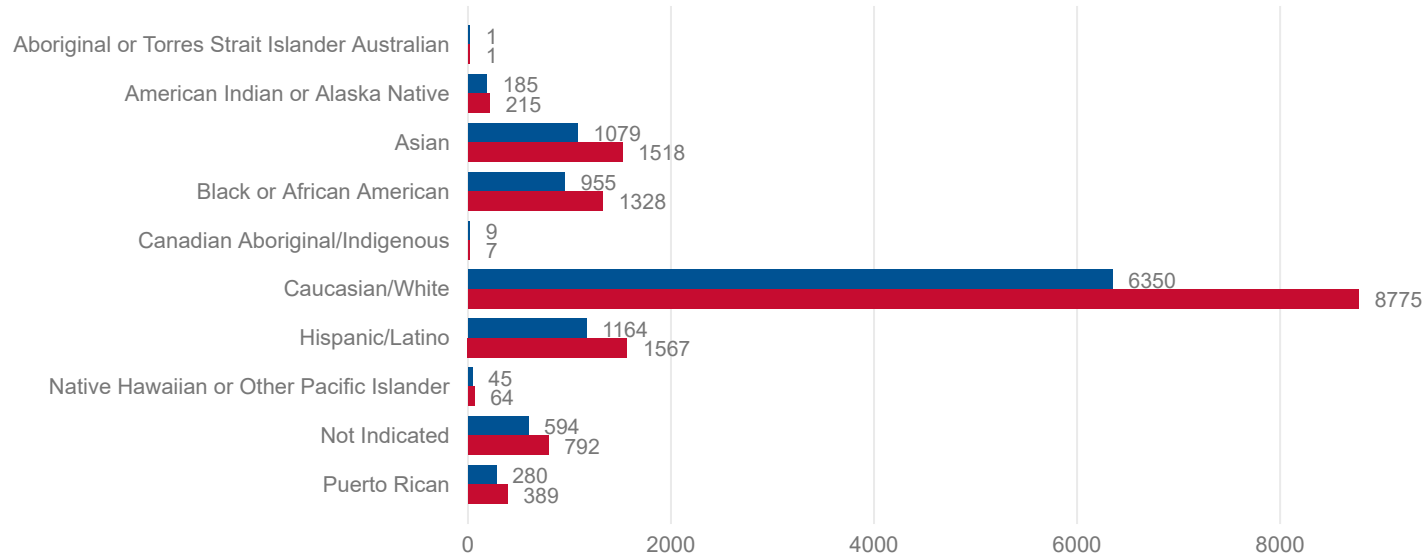

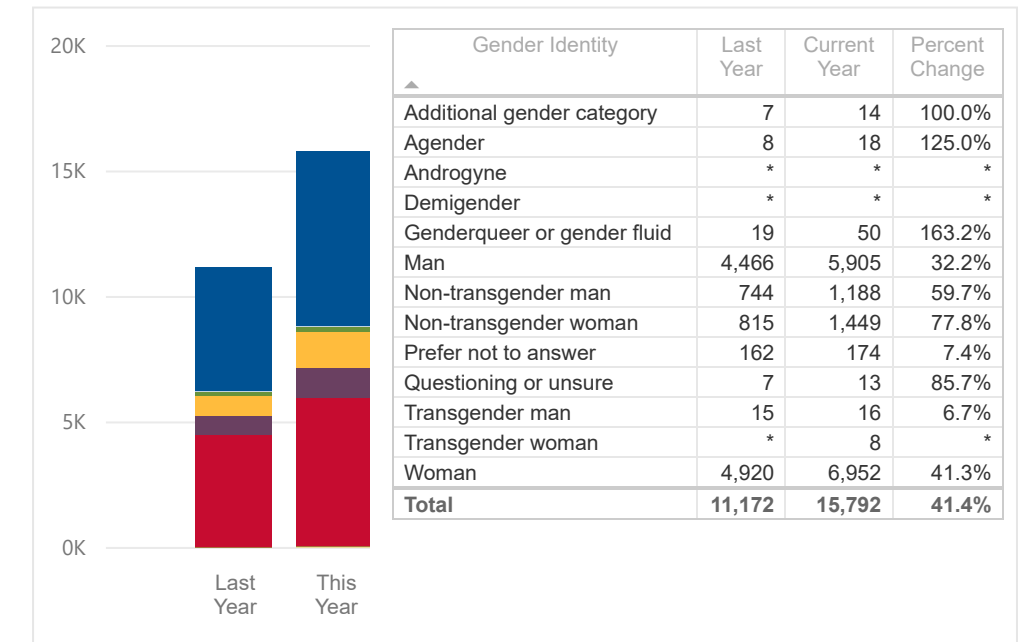

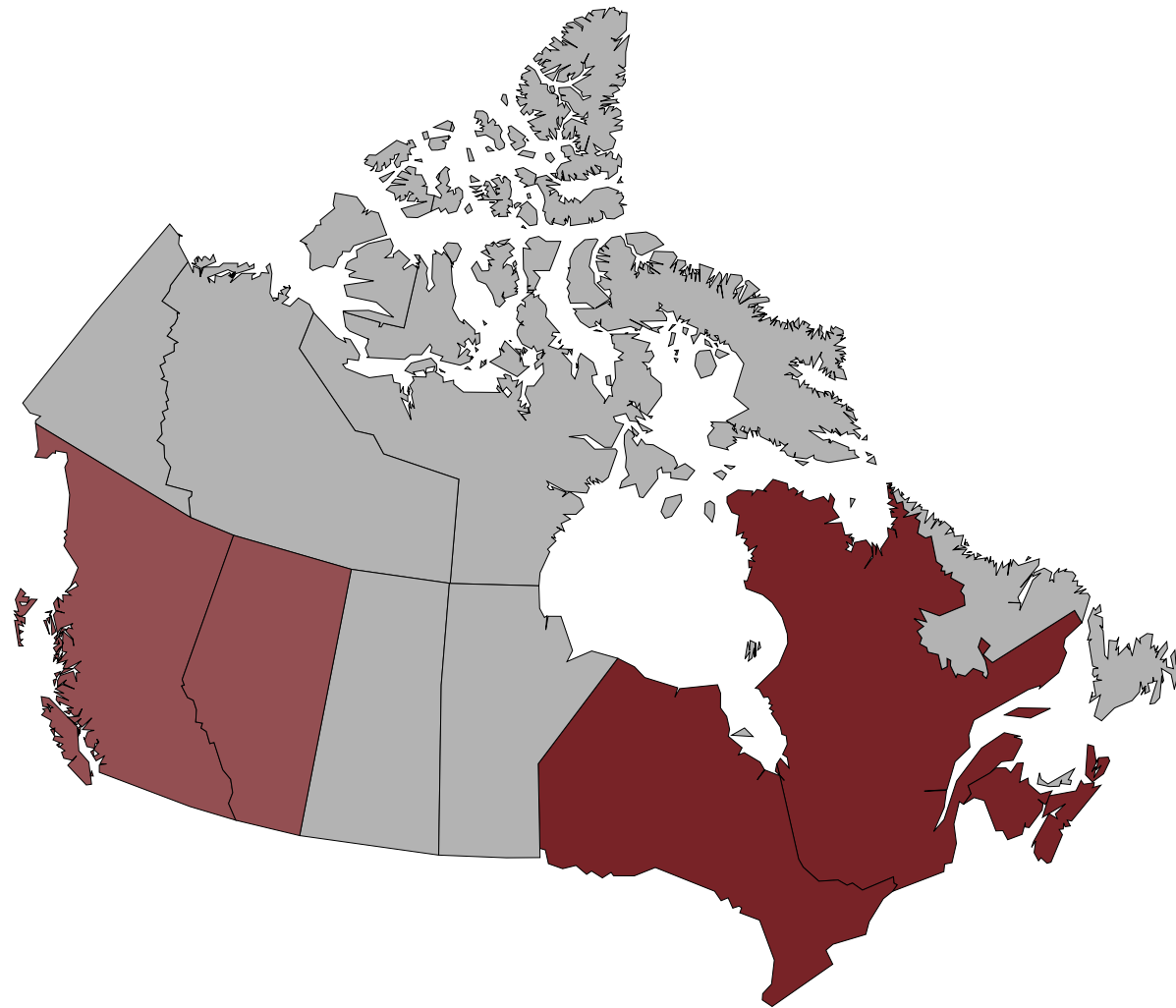

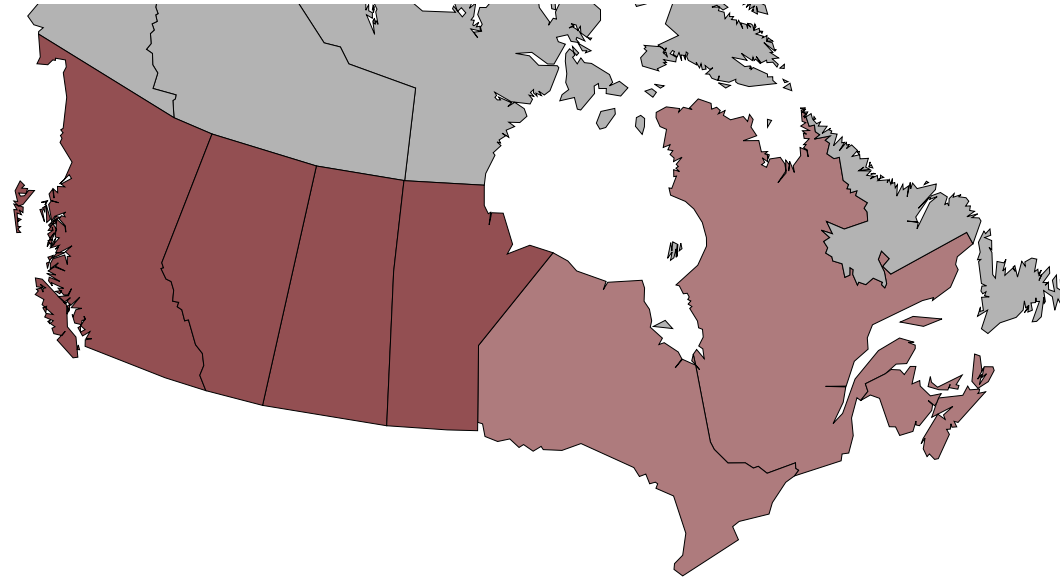

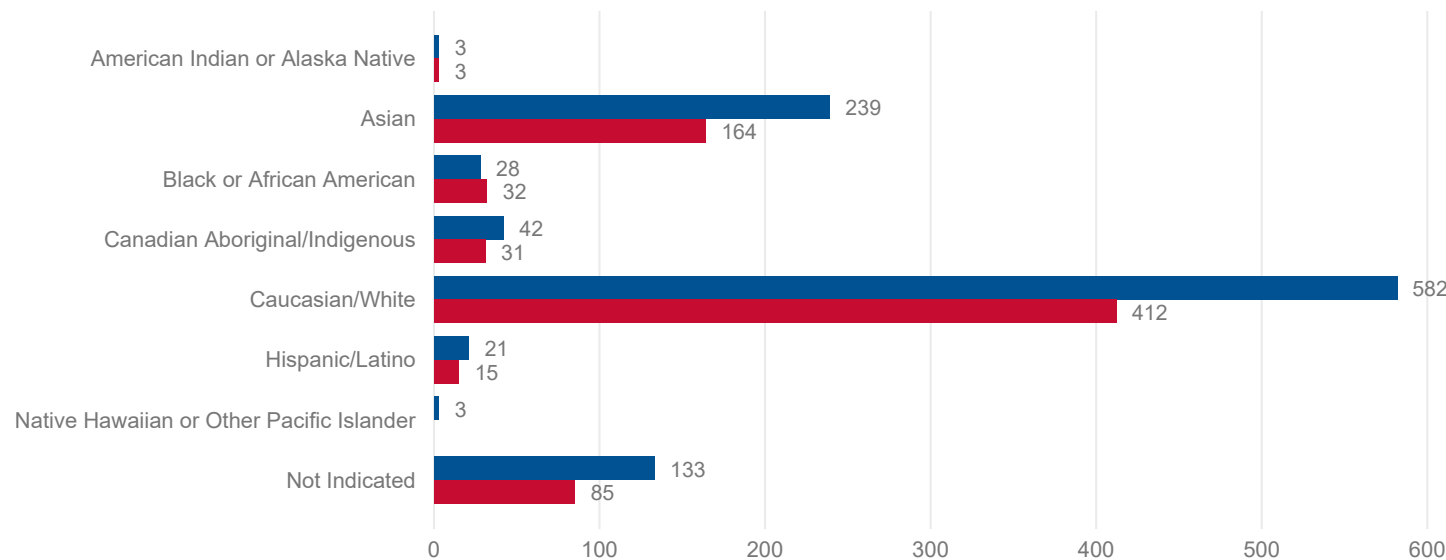
